

## OpenFreight by Freightos - Free License

OpenFreight.org is developed by Freightos to promote data interoperability and standardization in the logistics industry in order to reduce service provider costs and improve shipper experience.

Permission is hereby granted, free of charge, to any registered member who has completed the free registration to OpenFreight.org ("Members") to obtain a copy of the OpenFreight Data and API standards, sample documents, and any accompanying software (the "Standards") and to structure and transmit data and execute API calls according to the Standards, including without limitation the rights to use, copy, modify, merge, publish, distribute and/or sublicense copies of the Standards, and to permit persons to whom the Standards is furnished to do so, subject to the following conditions:

"Licensor" - Freightos Limited of Hong Kong ("Freightos")

"You" (or "Your") shall mean an individual or legal entity who is a member of OpenFreight.org and who is exercising permissions granted by this License.

1) Licensor grants You a worldwide, royalty-free, non-exclusive, sublicensable license to do the following:

- a) reproduce the Standards in copies, either alone or as part of a collective work;
- b) translate, adapt, alter, transform, modify, or arrange the Standards, thereby creating derivative works ("Derivative Works");
- c) create data documents and specific API calls structured to be compliant with the standard ("Data").

2) You hereby grant to Freightos a perpetual, worldwide, non-exclusive, no-charge, royalty-free, irrevocable license to any published and/or public Derivative Works without exclusion provided that Freightos adds these Derivative Works to the Standards and licenses it to all Members. So long as Your Derivative Works are not published, you are under no obligation to license them to Freightos. You are never required to license any Data to Freightos.

3) Use of this License is limited to members of OpenFreight.org. Any use or granting of use of this License or of Derivative Works to or by non-members of OpenFreight.org

shall be deemed non-licensed use and an infringement of Freightos and OpenFreight.org intellectual property rights.

4) This License does not grant permission to use the trade names, trademarks, service marks, or product names of the Licensor, except as required for reasonable and customary use in describing the origin of the Standards and for attribution of the Standards.

5) This License and attribution of the Standards to Freightos and to OpenFreight.org shall be included in all copies or substantial portions of the Standards and in all Derivative Works and Data as detailed in Appendix A to this License.

7) Limitation of Liability. Under no circumstances and under no legal theory, whether in tort (including negligence), contract, or otherwise, shall the Licensor be liable to anyone for any indirect, special, incidental, or consequential damages of any character arising as a result of this License or the use of the Standards including, without limitation, damages for loss of goodwill, work stoppage, computer failure or malfunction, or any and all other commercial damages or losses.

8) Termination. This License shall terminate immediately and You may no longer exercise any of the rights granted to You by this License upon any breach of the provisions of this License or should you no longer be a member of OpenFreight.org.

9) Termination for Patent Action. This License shall terminate automatically and You may no longer exercise any of the rights granted to You by this License as of the date You commence an action, including a cross-claim or counterclaim, against Licensor or any licensee alleging that the Standards infringes a patent or other intellectual property rights.
